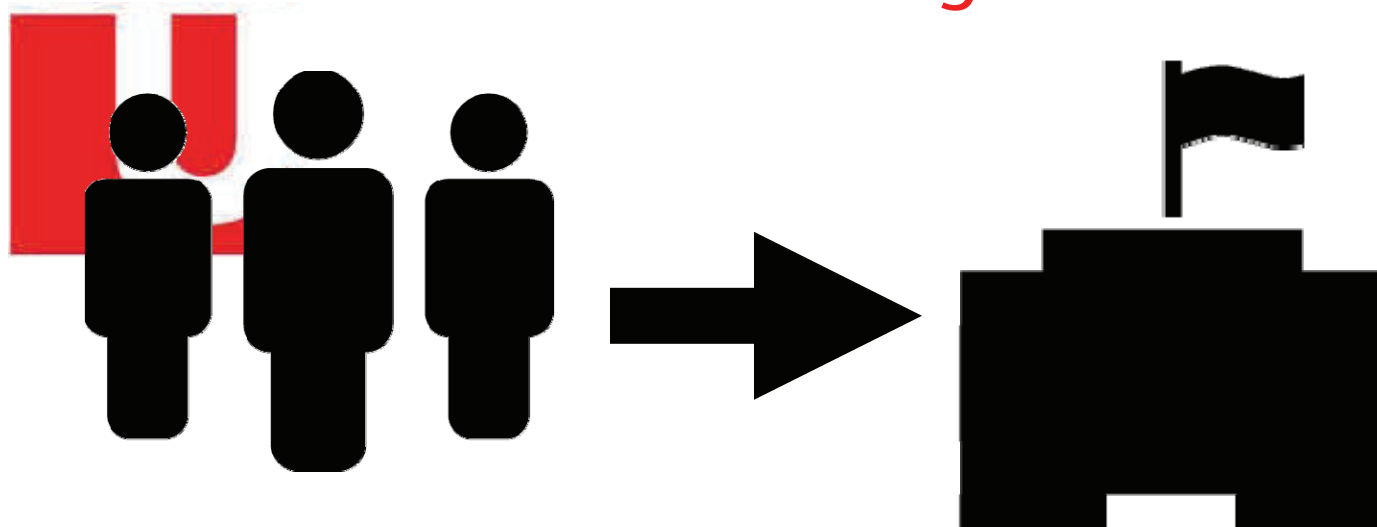


# Partnering with York
