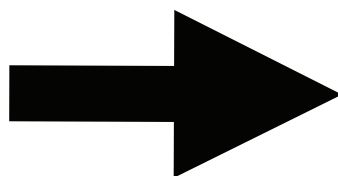
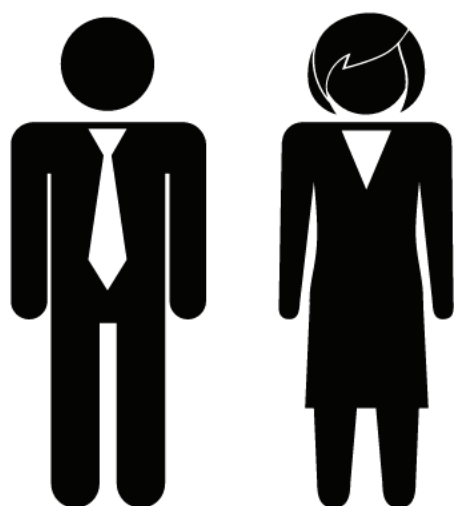


Partnering with York
